HEALTHY SCHOOL MEALS FOR ALL (HB25-1274)

Colorado's Healthy School Meals for All program provides more than 600,000 free meals to students each day, which reduces stigma, ensures students' nutritional needs are met and eases the financial burden on families and school budgets. Supporting House Bill 25-1274 means voters will get a chance to approve fully funding and implementing this successful program!

Healthy School Meals for All keeps kids fed AND saves families up to \$1,300 per child per year!





We need additional funding to keep kids fed AND implement the voter approved elements that are currently on hold due to funding shortfalls: training & increased wages for the people who prepare & serve meals, and partnerships with local farmers to include fresh, healthy ingredients & support local economies.

RETAIN

The bill refers a ballot measure for voters to agree to keep all the funds raised by Proposition FF to continue feeding kids, rather than returning a portion of the money to wealthy Coloradans.

RAISE

To meet the high need for school meals, this legislation refers a measure to ask voters to approve further lowering tax deductions for people making \$300,000 or more to provide additional funds.

SUSTAIN

The bill creates a reserve & process for phasing in investment in wages, local purchasing & support for preparing tasty meals using local foods while ensuring the financial health & sustainability of the program.



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How does this bill help fully fund & implement HSMA?

- Asks voters to approve raising up to \$95M in <u>additional revenue</u> by further lowering tax deduction limits for people who make more than \$300,000 a year to ensure long-term stability & enable all components are implemented.
- Asks voters to approve <u>retaining the funds raised</u> through Prop FF to support the program rather than sending refunds to wealthy Coloradans. This is a requirement of our state Taxpayer's Bill of Rights (TABOR).

We will continue to work with legislators and partners to refine these measures to ensure we can create long-term program sustainability by incorporating new developments at the federal level, updated 24-25 program data and the latest economic forecasts and voter research.



How will this bill help farmers & local economies?

The bill seeks to continue & expand the successful Local Food Purchasing Program that helps schools purchase & prepare meals with food from Colorado farmers & ranchers. Since this program began, **over \$2M has been directed to local food, resulting in a \$3.4M boost to local economies.**

More than \$750,000 has also been invested in training & technical assistance to connect producers & schools and provide culinary skills to create consistent and sustainable market channels for our producers.




How does this bill help kids & families?

- Students who eat at school have **improved attendance**, **behavior**, **academic performance**, and academic achievement as well as decreased tardiness.
- Receiving a school lunch **reduces poor health by at least 29%** and is linked with fewer visits to the school nurse & reductions in behavioral problems.
- Research shows children are getting their healthiest meals at school.




